



### **Chairs Report – 2016/17**

We have had another successful year raising funds for school via several PSA events. Thank you as ever for your support.

The annual spring walk turned into a Superhero Stomp, which raised almost £2000, including matched funds from Barclays. Visitors enjoyed massages, manicures, reflexology and threading, as well as plenty of shopping opportunities at our amazing Pamper Night, with over £1000 raised at this event. The Christmas Fair, Plaxtol Vision and the Summer Fair were our other big events, and each raised a record amount in comparison to previous years.

The big spend this year was the refurbishment of the Resources Room, which now has a full kitchen, moveable work spaces and tall science lab type stools. The room will be used as a break out area for Class 4 as well as for art, science and food tech.

We also provided money for a reading corner for Class 3, funding for a break out area for the lower school outside Classes 1 & 2, funding for iXL, numbershark and wordshark software to support learning in class, money for classroom supplies and much more.

The Wildlife Garden has also benefitted from an influx of donations this year, including children's gardening gloves, spades, hand tools, a hedgehog house, seeds, pond equipment and compost bins.
